



## FAQs | Kawana Touch Association

### What is Touch Football?

Touch Football is a fast-paced, low-contact sport played with an oval shaped ball, similar to that used in rugby league. The game involves passing and running, where players attempt to score touchdowns by grounding the ball over the opponent's try line. The key distinction is that instead of tackling, players must touch their opponents to stop their progress.

Touch footy is typically played with 6 players to a field, and approximately 10-12 players total to a team to allow for substituting throughout the game.

### What nights do you play?

#### Adult Competitions

- MONDAY: Mixed
- WEDNESDAY: Men's, Women's

### Can I register as an individual?

### What equipment do I need to play touch footy?

You will need a team jersey with a number on the back which will be organised and supplied by your team. We recommend wearing suitable footwear such as football boots, otherwise running shoes with sufficient grip. You may also want to bring a water bottle and any other additional personal items you require during the game.

### How does the Touch Football Australia membership fee work?

As of 1 July 2023, Touch Football Australia (TFA) transitioned to a National Membership Model. The TFA Affiliation and Insurance components previously paid as part of team



affiliation (\$150.70 per senior team and \$64.90 per junior team per season), will now form part of the National Membership.

From now on, when a player registers to MySideline in their first competition/event, they will be prompted to pay an individual National Membership fee of \$22.00 (inc GST).

The TFA National Membership is an annual fee paid once, providing membership from 1 July 2023 - 30 June 2024.
